

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities ActADA), Disability Support Services (DSS) provides academic accommodations, promotes removal of access barriers, and provides other services for students with disabilities to have equitable access to educational and college experiences. DSS modifies or eliminates learning barriers through the provision of accommodation services.

Accommodation services provided include, but are not limited to:

- DSS provides accommodations to all NIC students (Dual, WTC, Parker Tech, Sandpoint, Main Campus) as well as to NIHE school students on the CDA campus
